Membership Dues Information

Philanthropy Northwest's fiscal year runs from January 1 through December 31 and applications are reviewed regularly throughout the year. Annual dues are based on the total dollar amount of cash grants or contributions paid in the previous fiscal year. If this is a financial hardship for your foundation or grantmaking organization, dues may be calculated based upon giving in our member states (Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Washington and Wyoming).

If you represent a new grantmaking organization and have yet to make any grants, you are eligible for membership at our lowest dues level. Foundations may exclude "pass-through" funds from their dues calculations (funds that are totally restricted or externally controlled, or where the foundation acts solely as a fiscal agent). Foundations should include any "restricted funds" that are part of the foundation's endowment or monies over which the foundation has some control of allocation and serves as more than just a fiscal agent.
