Award Types

DEVELOPMENT

Award: Up to \$350,000

Length of grant: 2 years

Example projects:

- Blueprints, schematics or permitting
- Public outreach and education on environmental issues
- Land purchase
- Project implementation, like improving healthy food access or reducing air or water pollution

PLANNING

Award: Up to \$250,000

Length of grant: 1–2 years

Example projects:

- Partnership building with community
- Public outreach and education on environmental issues
- Community trainings
- Community involvement projects, like cleaning up a vacant lot

ASSESSMENT

Award: Up to \$150,000

Length of grant: 1 year

Example projects:

- Environmental testing and monitoring
- Qualitative or quantitive research
- Surveys or studies
- Public outreach and education on environmental issues

Eligibility

Tribal nations, nonprofits, local governments and higher education institutions are eligible to apply.
